Artisan Mind offers on-going classes that provide powerful engagement tools and practical strategies that can be woven into daily activity programs and community outreach efforts.



Since 2003, Artisan Mind affiliate ARTZ: Artists for Alzheimer's and The I'm Still Here Foundation have been engaging participants during museum tours in a way that is specifically designed to reach people living with dementia.

During each creative experience we create a forum in which

- Participants express their emotions and opinions.
- Families and care partners learn new forms of communication.
- The "4 A's" associated with dementia – anxiety, agitation, apathy and aggression- are reduced.

Classes available for memory care, skilled nursing, adult day care and assisted living communities.
